The Office of Provider of People (Labor Bureau) in Ancient Egypt

Abstract

This article deals with one of the administrative offices, the Office provider of people, which can be defined as Labor Bureau, or the Service Office, only known in the late Middle Kingdom. Researchers hold different views concerning the meaning and translation of the expression of this administrative office, and the nature of its functions. This article aims at determining the exact meaning of the name of this office, recognizing the administrative structure and the nature of its staff, defining the specializations and nature of the missions of this administrative office, deciding the time of its appearance and disappearance and discovering the organization to which it was subject.
