A Remarkable Stela from the second Intermediate Period Manal Affara

This research studies funeral stela, carrying the title and the name of *s3t nswt Nfr htp*. The painting was found in the cemetery Northern Kom es-Sultan in Abydos; where they now are on the ground floor in the warehouse of the Department of Central State, and bearing the number CG 20058. The importance of this research highlights an accurate description of the scenery, and in-depth study of the texts, and analyzed as well as the correction of errors that were carried out by the sculptor in writing texts. The importance of this study lies in identifying the historical period of the painting and funerary stela they are likely due to the late Dynasty XIII. The study also includes a discussion about whether the title *s3* (*t*) *nsw* (*t*) *qf Nfr htp* people and representatives on the panel funeral, means that they are already of the royal family or not.
